- Before and After School Care available for an additional fee.
- Central ECC is in compliance with the Missouri Department of Health.
- CECC is a ministry of Central United Methodist Church.
- Parent participation is encouraged in planning holiday parties, bringing class snacks, donating supplies, serving on our advisory board, assisting with fundraisers, or sharing a special skill or talent during day-to-day activities.
- Health forms, signed by a physician, are required for attendance.
- Monthly newsletters are sent home to keep parents informed about activities.
- Parent-Teacher Conferences are held twice per year, and communication between parents and teachers is encouraged on a daily basis.
- Discounts in tuition are given to families with multiple children enrolled or Central United Methodist Church members. Discounted rates for full-time enrollment are also provided.

Tuition...

Tuition is charged monthly based upon the number of days per week a child is enrolled. *Children are required to be enrolled for a minimum of 2 days.* Full Time or Fully Enrolled, Multiple child or Central UMC discounts are available. Extended day classes are available for an additional fee. Age ranges are approximate and reflect the age of the child in August.



A non-refundable enrollment fee of \$50.00 and the first month's tuition are due at the time of enrollment.

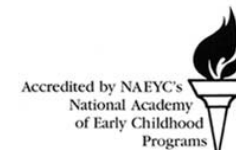

Classes, Ages and Schedules...

- All classes meet from 9:30 a.m. until 2:00 p.m.
- AM Extended Day available 7:30 – 9:30 a.m.
- PM Extended Day available 2:00-5:30 p.m.
- Age ranges are approximate and reflect the child's age in August.
- All classes use Creative Curriculum. Activities are open-ended and developmentally appropriate to meet the needs and interests of those enrolled. Teachers make changes in equipping the classroom as the developmental abilities and interests change throughout the school year.
- Directors make final decision in class placements to meet individual, classroom, and program needs.

Families can **choose** as many as five days per week or as few as two days per week to meet their individual needs. These classes also serve children who may not have begun toilet training or who are not completely toilet trained and who are not yet independent in taking care of those needs. Each group is offered the same curriculum framework within a **flexible** schedule.

Set Schedule Classes

Rainbow or Dinosaur classes are for children 3-5 years who have completely accomplished **toilet-learning (no pull-ups)**; and are **independent** about handling his/her own needs. Each of these classes has **three enrollment options**. Children may be enrolled for either: **Mon., Wed., Fri. OR Tue., Thu. OR Monday through Friday classes**. Each group is offered the same curriculum framework within a **set** schedule.

Extended Day Info...

Whether your child needs more learning & play time, or the core hours are just not enough to meet the needs of your family's schedule, CECC is here for you! We offer **Before School care** from 7:30-9:30 a.m. M- F and **After School care** from 2:00-5:30 p.m. M- F. Children need to be currently enrolled in CECC to enroll in Extended Day classes.

Enrollment begins in February. Currently enrolled families have placement priority. After March 1, all new children will be placed in classes in the order that applications were received.

Parent Orientation - Monday, August 16, 2010: At this evening event, parents meet the teachers; learn more about the programs & visit the classroom.

Children's Orientation - Tuesday, August 17, 2010: Children meet their teacher(s) & visit their classrooms, at scheduled times between 9:00 a.m. and noon.
